Each year since then, we hold a Gala Dinner Auction at Orlando's Event and Conference Center. The evening starts with many delectable hors d'oeuvres. Guests peruse the silent auction items while listening to wonderful live music. The night features an elegant four-course dinner prepared by Orlando's Executive Chef, followed by a brief live auction to increase the evenings proceeds. At the end of the evening all the charities are asked to come forth to enter their names in the drawing.

Any 501(c)3 charity can be represented through the purchase of a table at the dinner auction. A portion of the ticket price is tax deductible. For every table purchased representing an eligible charity, an entry into the drawing is awarded. Following the auction, three drawings will take place and the charities chosen will receive the net proceeds, traditionally between \$25,000-\$40,000.
